Departure from USA to Krakow, Poland

Check in 3 hours before the flight time at the USA airport

Arrive in Krakow, Poland

Shire of Divine Mercy

Visit the Chapel with relics of St. Faustina.

Wadowicer visit the homeland (especially the childhood home) of Pope John Paul II. Offering Mass in the church where he was baptized

Pay tribute to Our Lady of Black Black Madonna Częstochowa:

considered the most famous temple in Poland, with many Catholics pilgrimages there every year. Since 1711. Pope John Paul II secretly visited as a student pilgrimage during World War II.

Visit the Wieliczka salt mine & Visit the gorgeous Wieliczka church under the lights with statues of God and statues of John Paul II made of salt because the church is in the heart of the salt mine

Day 5 I August 9, 2024: Krakow - Prague, Czechoslovakia

City Tour walk to admire Castle Square, Charles Bridge, St Vitus Cathedral, Church of St Nicholas, Chicken Square.

Visit the beautiful Plitvice Lake, home to 16 terraced lakes surrounded by densely wooded mountains

Visit Our Lady of Medjugorje - Apparition Hill-pray the Rosary and ask for her blessings; Visit Mother's Village, St. Francis Garden, visit Cenacolo Community, visit St. James Church-attend Eucharistic Adoration, blessing of healing

Mount of the Cross–Cross of the Risen Christ–see the 14 Ways of the Cross; visit St. James Church–participate in the Sacrament Adoration, the blessing of healing

Visit the city of Athens

Pass through the port of Cenchreae where St. Paul departed for Ephesus, today Turkey – Santorini Island

Day 13 | August 17, 2024: Santorini

Visit the town of Fira on This is a town with light or white houses, adorned with blue windows

Day 14 | August 18, 2024: Santorini - Athens

Visit Santorini Island beach

Afternoon check out the train to Athens

Visit the Parthenon on the hill, visit the Olympic Hall in the afternoon and ancient Greek monuments

Day 15 | August 19, 2024: Athens

Set out to visit the Churches in the city of Athens, where St. Paul preached to the Greeks and they did not receive him.

Shrine of Divine Mercy

The Temple of Divine Mercy in Kraków, Poland, is a Roman Catholic basilica dedicated to devotion to Divine Mercy, and the resting place of Faustina Kowalska, canonized by the Catholic Church on August 30, 2000

Wadowice

Wadowice is known as the birthplace of Karol Wojtyła, later Pope John Paul II

Black Madonna Częstochowa

As a revered icon of the Virgin Mary is located at the Jasna Góra Monastery in Częstochowa, Poland. Pope Clement XI issued a Papal decree on the canonical coronation of the image on September 8, 1717 through the Vatican Chapter. It also deserves the three golden roses of the pope

Medjugorje

Medjugorje is a town in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It has been an unofficial Catholic pilgrimage site since the Virgin Mary was said to have appeared on the Apparitions Hill in 1981. There is a statue of 'Queen of Peace' marking the site of the first apparition and a statue in front of St. James's Church.

Diocletian Palace

Is an ancient palace built for the Roman emperor Diocletian in the late third century AD, today occupying about half the ancient town of Split, Croatia.



Mariazell Church

Is a Roman Catholic church building in Mariazell, Austria. It is the most important Christian pilgrimage destination in Austria and one of the most visited temples in Europe. In the church, a miraculous wooden statue of the Virgin Mary is revered.

Parthenon

Is an old temple in the Athenian Acropolis, Greece, dedicated to the goddess Athena in the fifth century BC. Its decorative sculptures are considered one of the pinnacles of Greek art, a lasting symbol of ancient Greece, democracy and the West.



Santorini

Famous for its impressive views, stunning sunsets from the town of Oia, the ancient city ruins of Thera and Akrotiri, unique wines, artists and craftsmen, an active volcano and black or red volcanic pebble beaches.
