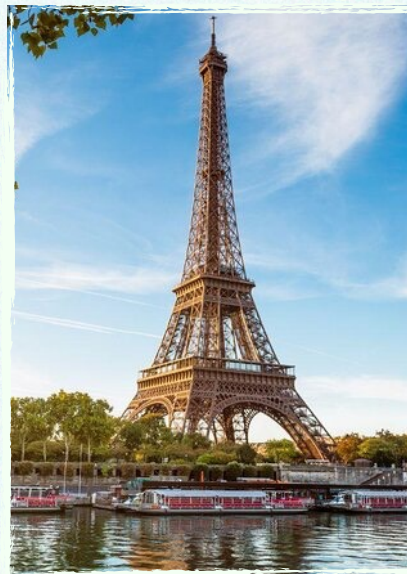

Day 1 | May 12, 2024: USA Airport - FCO Airport

Check in 3 hours before the flight time at the USA airport

Day 2 | May 13, 2024: Roma

Visit the Saint Paul's Outside the Walls

Day 3 | May 14, 2024: Roma

Visit the Patriarch of Peter, visit the resting place of Saint Pope John Paul II, the statue of the Mother of Sorrow

Visit St John Laterano. Admire a wooden sample from the True Cross, the crucifix nails, thorns from the crown of thorns, the sign 'King of the Jews', the index finger of St. Thomas, kneeling on the Holy Stairs.

Visit and admire the manger of the Child Jesus brought by St. Helena from Bethlehem (Holy Land).

Day 4 | May 15, 2024: Roma

Go to Papal Audience

Visit the Basilica and Tomb of St. Francis.

Visit St. Claire's Church

Day 5 | May 16, 2024: Rome - Assisi - Venice, Italy

Padua: Visit St. Anthony Padova, St. Anthony's Basilica

Venice : Visit the Basilica of St. Mark's Cathedral. A national treasure of the Republic of Venice until 1797 and since 1807 as the cathedral of Venice. St. Mark's Church was built between 829 and 832 to store the remains of St. Mark brought here by Venetian merchants from Alexandria. St. Mark is said to have gone on a mission in Alexandria and served as a diocesan Bishop here. This time, the Saint wrote the Gospel. Today, St. Mark's Square & Basilica are indispensable stops for visitors to visit the city of Venice.

Day 6 | May 17, 2024: Venice - Padua - Lucerne, Switzerland

Milan : free time lunch, city tour : Visit the Duomo di Milano, located in Northern Italy. one of the famous Catholic churches in Italy and the 4th largest church in the world. . there are more than 3,400 statues and paintings of saints

Lake Lucerne - one of the four largest and most beautiful lakes in Switzerland. You can relax on the shore of the poetic lake, can watch the swans playing freely on the lake

Chapel Bridge The Chapel Bridge is a wooden bridge in Luzern, Switzerland, 240 meters (670 feet) long, across the banks of the Reuss River, near the exit to Lake Lucerne, which is the oldest surviving wooden bridge in Europe. This is a prominent place and attracts many tourists in Switzerland

Day 7 | May 18, 2024: Lucerne - Paris, France

Visit the Arc de Triomphe and walk to visit Des Champs - Elysees, Eiffel Tower

Visit the city of Paris and Take a cruise along the Seine

Day 8 | May 19, 2024: Paris

Visit St. Church Vicent de Paul, Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Sacred Heart Basilica - Sacred Heart Basilica, Visit Notre Dame Paris Cathedral of Notre Dame de Paris

Free time shopping

Day 9 | May 20, 2024: Paris - Lisieux - Paris

Visit the largest Church in France - Basilique Sainte - Therese. Visit the small house of St. Therese. - Visit the tomb of St. Therese.

Day 10 | May 21, 2024: Paris - Lourdes

Day 11 | May 22, 2024: Lourdes

Visit Our Lady of Lourdes - bathe and drink spring water; Retreat and Healing; procession of candles to Our Lady; Visit 2 Basilicas: Our Lady of the Rosary and the Immaculate Conception; Via Crucis - the Way of the Way of the Cross; Visit Boly Mill - where St. Bernadette was born;

Day 12 | May 23, 2024: Lourdes - Barcelona

Barcelona : Visiting Antoni Gaudi's incomplete, beautiful Roman Catholic Church, La Sagrada Familia

Day 13 | May 24, 2024: Barcelona

Visit the stunning views of the Port of Barcelona, Montjuic, the Plaza de España and the Plaza de Catalunya. This port was created about 2000 years ago. The Plaza de España is located just outside the town center, formerly known for its old bullfighting arena. Currently, the Plaza is famous for having the Catalan Art Museum, located on the Montjuic side.. Plaza de Catalunya is located in the heart of Barcelona and is known for its fountains and statues. Your day of sightseeing will continue with a guided walk through the Gothic Quarter containing relics from an ancient Roman village.

Day 14 | May 25, 2024: Montserrat - Manresa- Zaragoza - Avila

Manresa : Visit the Sanctuary of St. Ignatius Loyola and the Holy Cave where St. Ignatius lives.

Montserrat: Visit the Black Madonna Cathedral

Zaragoza: Visit the Basilica del Pilar La Seo Cathedral (Zaragoza Cathedral) is officially known as the church of San Vicente. The Visigoth period contained Gothic, Mudejar, Renaissance and Baroque architectures. Visit the city of Madrid

Day 15 | May 26, 2024: Avila - Fatima

Avila : Visit the Romanesque de Avila Cathedral surrounded by an 11th-century wall that surrounded the old, Gothic and Renaissance streets of the same time with works of art and architecture. La Basilica de San Vicente in Avila is located on the site of the martyrdom of St. Vincent.

Visit the Carmelite Monastery (secret order), where St. Teresa Avila became a nun

Visit Alade Tormes Village : . The town is home to the Carmelite Monastery that St. Teresa founded in 1571, at the Abbey where she died and was buried. Visit the museum dedicated to St. Teresa of Avila

Fatima : Procession of Mother Fatima

Day 16 | May 27, 2024: Fatima

Visit Our Lady of Fatima, Our Lady of the Apparitions in 1917 With 3 Young Saints, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta

Day 17 | May 28, 2024: Fatima

Excursions



Venice, Italy

Is a city in northeastern Italy and the capital of the Veneto region. It is built on a group of 126 islands separated by vast bodies of water and canals; parts of the city are connected by 472 bridges. The islands are located in the shallow Venetian lagoon

Assisi, Italy

As the site of many pilgrimages, Assisi is associated in legend with its native son, St. Francis. The gentle saint founded the Franciscan order and shared the honor with St. Catherine of Siena as the patron saint of Italy.



Vatican

There are religious and cultural sites such as St. Peter's Church, the Sistine Chapel, the Vatican Apostolic Library and the Vatican Museum. They have some of the world's most famous paintings and sculptures.

Lucerne

As a city in central Switzerland, in the German-speaking part of the country. Lucerne is the capital of the state of Lucerne and is part of the district of the same name

Barcelona

A city on the northeast coast of Spain. It is the capital and largest city of the autonomous community of Catalonia, as well as Spain's second most populous metropolis.



Avila

Known by its medieval walls, Ávila is sometimes referred to as the Stone and Holy Town, and it claims that it is one of the towns with the highest number of Roman and Gothic churches per capita in Spain.

Montserrat Black Madonna

A title of Our Lady is associated with a statue of Our Lady and Child venerated at the monastery of Santa Maria de Montserrat on Mount Montserrat in Catalonia, Spain. She is the patron saint of Catalonia

Đức Mẹ Lộ Đức

She is revered by the Roman Catholic Church under this title due to her apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France. The first apparition was on February 11, 1858, in which Bernadette Soubirous told her mother that a "Lady" had spoken to her in the Massabielle cave while she was foraging firewood with her sister and a friend.



Fatima

Is a central town of Portugal, where the Sanctuary of Fátima is located, a Catholic pilgrimage site. Capelinha das Aparições marks the place where the Virgin Mary appeared in 1917.

Payment Details

Tour price includes:

Regulations when registering:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 per person is required at the time of booking along with the booking application.

Our costs are in USD. The price is for each person is based on double occupancy/room.

Cancellation Policy :

- A non-refundable \$500/person subscription fee is included in the package unless the trip is cancelled by our office due to low enrollment.
- 90 days before departure, a 20% cancellation fee is charged
- 60 days before departure cancellation fee 30%
- 30 days before departure date 50% cancellation fee
- 20 days or less before departure, 100% cancellation fee
