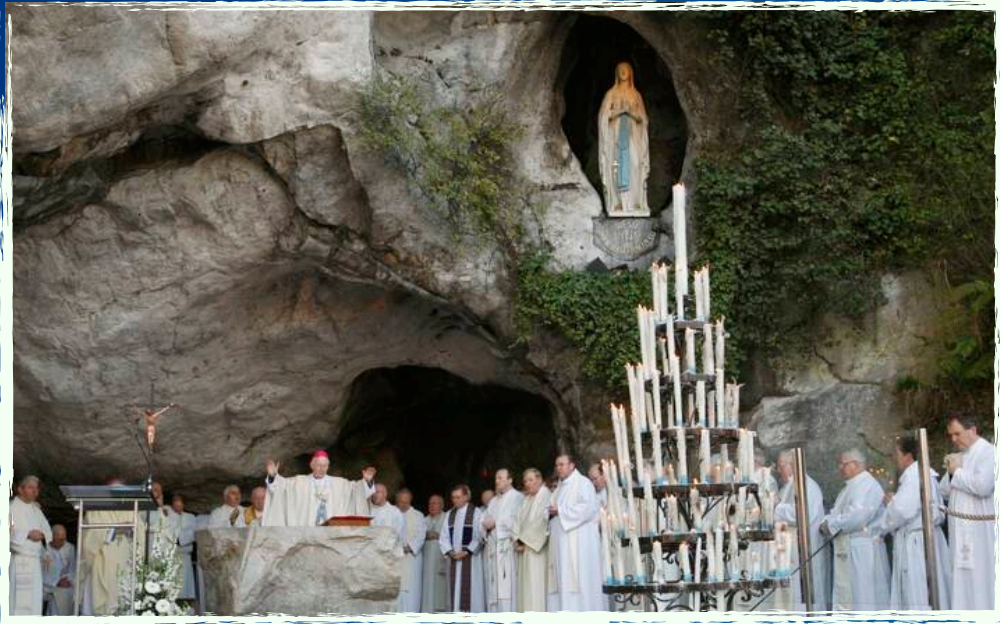

Itinerary

Day 1 | October 11, 2024: USA to Lisbon, Portugal

Depart from USA to Lisbon, Portugal

Check in 3 hours before the flight time at the USA airport

Day 2 | October 12, 2024: Lisbon, Portugal

Fatima: Procession of Mother Fatima

Day 3 | October 13, 2024: Fatima

Visit Our Lady of Fatima, Our Lady of the Apparitions in 1917 With 3 Young Saints, Lucia, Francisco and Jacinta

Day 4 | October 14, 2024: Fatima - Avila

Avila: Visit the Romanesque de Avila Cathedral surrounded by an 11th-century wall that surrounded the old, Gothic and Renaissance town of the same time with works of art and architecture. La Basilica de San Vicente in Avila is located on the site of the martyrdom of St. Vincent.

Visit the Carmelite Monastery (secret order), where St. Teresa Avila became a nun

Visit Alade Tormes Village: This town is home to the Carmelite Monastery that St. Teresa founded in 1571, at the Monastery where she died and was buried. Visit the museum dedicated to St. Teresa of Avila

Day 5 | October 15, 2024: Avila - Zaragoza - Manresa - Montserrat

Zaragoza: Visit the Basilica del Pilar La Seo Cathedral (Zaragoza Cathedral) is officially known as the church of San Vicente. The Visigoth period contained Gothic, Mudejar, Renaissance and Baroque architectures. Visit the city of Madrid

Manresa: Visit the Sanctuary of St. Ignatius Loyola and the Holy Cave where St. Ignatius lives

Montserrat: Visit the Black Madonna Cathedral

Day 6 | October 16, 2024: Barcelona

Visit the beautiful Roman Catholic Church of Antoni Gaudi, La Sagrada Familia

Itinerary

Visit the stunning views of the Port of Barcelona, Montjuic, **the Plaza de España and the Plaza de Catalunya**. This port was created about 2000 years ago. The Plaza de España is located just outside the town center, formerly known for its old bullfighting arena. Currently, the Plaza is famous for having the Catalan Art Museum, located on the Montjuic side.. Plaza de Catalunya is located in the heart of Barcelona and is known for its fountains and statues. Your day of sightseeing will continue with a guided walk through the Gothic Quarter containing relics from an ancient Roman village.

Day 7 | October 17, 2024: Barcelona - Lourdes

Procession of Our Lady of Lourdes

Day 8 | October 18, 2024: Lourdes

Lourdes: Visit Our Lady of Lourdes – bathe and drink spring water; Retreat and Healing; procession of candles to Our Lady; Visiting 2 Basilicas: Our Lady of the Rosary and the Immaculate Conception; Via Crucis – the road of the Way of the Cross; Visit Boly Mill – where St. Bernadette was born;

Day 9 | October 19, 2024: Lourdes to CDG Airport

Check out from the hotel and fly to Paris

Paris: Visit the Arc de Triomphe and walk to visit Des Champs-Elysees, Eiffel Tower

Visit the city of Paris and Take a cruise along the Seine

Day 10 | October 20, 2024: Paris - Lisieux - Paris

Visit the largest Church in France – Basilique Sainte – Therese. Visit the little house of St. Therese. – Visit the tomb of St. Therese

Day 11 | October 21, 2024: Paris

Visit St. Vicent de Paul Church, Chapel of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal. Sacred Heart Basilica - Sacred Heart Basilica, Visiting Notre Dame Paris Cathedral of Notre Dame de Paris.

Day 12 | October 22, 2024: Paris - Rome

Check out from the hotel and fly to Rome

Itinerary

Visit St John Laterano Basilica. Admire a wooden sample from the True Cross, the crucifix nails, thorns from the crown of thorns, the sign 'King of the Jews', the index finger of St. Thomas, kneeling on the Holy Stairs. Visit the Cathedral of Saint Ba Ca, admire the manger of the Child Jesus brought by St. Helena from Bethlehem (Holy Land). Taking pictures in front of The Colosseum

Day 13 | October 23, 2024: Rome

Visit St. Peter's Square for Papal audience with Pope Francis (depending on his weather & health). At noon, go to **Giovanni Rotondo**, where Father Pius received the miracle of the 5 stigmata, stopped by Lanciano to visit the Eucharistic Miracle, and celebrated Mass where the Bread and Wine had actually turned into the Body and Blood of God.

Day 14 | October 24, 2024: Rome - Assisi

Mass in the **Basilica of Our Lady of Grace & pray the Cross that Father Pius** prayed when he received the 5 Holy Marks. Visit the tomb of Father St. Pius and the place where Ivory once lived and worked.

Day 15 | October 25, 2024: Assisi - Rome

Visit the Basilicas & Tomb of St. Francis. Visit the Basilica and the tomb of St. Claire. Return to Rome at noon. Visit the Basilica of St. Paul's Basilica in the suburbs

Day 16 | October 26, 2024: Rome

Visit the St. Peter's Basilica, visit the grave of Saint Pope John Paul II, the statue of the Mother of Sorrow

Visit the Cathedra in Rome. admire the manger of the Child Jesus brought by St. Helena from Bethlehem (Holy Land).

Day 17 | October 27, 2024: Rome - USA

Our Lady of Fatima

Based on the Marian apparitions reported in 1917 by three shepherd children at the Cova da Iria in Fátima, Portugal. The three children are Lúcia dos Santos and cousins Francisco and Jacinta Marto.

Basilica of San Vicente

The Basilica of the martyrs' brothers, Vicente, Sabina and Cristeta, best known as the Basilica of San Vicente, is a church in Ávila, Spain. It is one of the best examples of Roman architecture in the country.



Sagrada Família

A church under construction in the Eixample district of Barcelona, Catalonia, Spain. This is the largest unfinished Catholic church in the world. Designed by Catalan architect Antoni Gaudí (1852–1926), his work on the Sagrada Família is part of a UNESCO World Heritage Site. On November 7, 2010, Pope Benedict XVI consecrated the church and declared it a small basilica.

Our Lady of Lourdes

Our Lady of Lourdes is revered by the Roman Catholic Church under this title due to her apparitions that occurred in Lourdes, France. The first appearance was on February 11, 1858, in which Bernadette Soubirous (14 years old) told her mother that a "Woman" had spoken to her in the Massabielle cave (1.5 km (0.93 miles) from town) while she was collecting firewood with her sister and a friend.

Champs Elysees

The Avenue des Champs-Élysées is an avenue in the 8th arrondissement of Paris, France, 1.9 km long and 70 meters wide, running between the Place de la Concorde to the east and the Place Charles de Gaulle to the west, where the Arc de Triomphe is located.



Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi

The main church of the Roman Catholic Order of the Small Monastery in Assisi, a town in the Umbria region of central Italy where St. Francis was born and died. This is a small papal basilica and one of the most important sites of Christian pilgrimage in Italy.

Colosseum in Rome

An elliptical amphitheatre in downtown Rome, Italy, just east of the Roman Forum. This is the largest ancient amphitharal ever built, and still the largest standing amphithera in the world, despite its age.

Vatican City

An independent state borderless to the sea, city-state, state and land within Rome, Italy.



Saint John Laterano Basilica

Is the Catholic cathedral of the Diocese of Rome in the city of Rome, and serves as the headquarters of the bishop of Rome, the pope. The basilica is located outside Vatican City, located about 4 kilometers (2.5 miles) to the northwest.

A non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 per person is required at the time of booking along with the booking application.

Cancellation Policy:

- A non-refundable \$500/person subscription fee is included in the package unless the trip is cancelled by our office due to low enrollment.
- 90 days before departure, a 20% cancellation fee is charged
- 60 days before departure cancellation fee 30%
- 30 days before departure date 50% cancellation fee
- 20 days or less before departure, 100% cancellation fee
