Excursions



Vatican City contains religious and cultural sites such as St. Peter's Basilica, the Sistine Chapel, and the Vatican Museums. They feature some of the world's most famous paintings and sculptures. The unique economy of Vatican City is supported financially by donations from the faithful, by the sale of postage stamps and souvenirs, fees for admission to museums, and sales of publications. Vatican City has no taxes and items are duty-free.

Papal Basilica of Saint Paul Outside the Walls is one of Rome's four major papal basilicas, along with the basilicas of Saint John in the Lateran, Saint Peter's, and Saint Mary Major, as well as one of the Seven Pilgrim Churches of Rome.





The Basilica of the Annunciation, is a Catholic church in Nazareth, in northern Israel. It is one of two claimants to the site of the Annunciation - in which angel Gabriel appeared to the Virgin Mary and announced that she would give birth to Jesus - the other being the Greek Orthodox Church of the Annunciation

Cana of Galilee is the location of the Marriage at Cana, at which the miracle of turning water into wine took place in the Gospel of John.

The Jordan River or River Jordan, s a 251-kilometer-long river in the Middle East that flows roughly north to south through the Sea of Galilee and on to the Dead Sea. Jordan and the Golan Heights border the river to the east, while the West Bank and Israel lie to its west.





Mount Zion is a hill in Jerusalem, located just outside the walls of the Old City. The term Mount Zion has been used in the Hebrew Bible first for the City of David and later for the Temple Mount, but its meaning has shifted and it is now used as the name of ancient Jerusalem's Western Hill

Petra is a historic and archaeological city in southern Jordan. It is adjacent to the mountain of Jabal Al-Madbah, in a basin surrounded by mountains forming the eastern flank of the Arabah valley running from the Dead Sea to the Gulf of Aqaba

The Dome of the Rock is an Islamic shrine located on the Temple Mount in the Old City of Jerusalem, a site also known to Muslims as the *al-Haram al-Sharif* or the Al-Aqsa Compound

Payment Details

Tour price includes:

You will pay \$500 registration fee, non-refundable. The remaining final payment is to be due 1 June, 2023.

Cancellation Policy:

- Non-refundable registration fee \$500/ person that is already included in the package unless the trip is cancelled by our office due to low numbers of registrations
- Airline Tickets are non refundable
- 90 days prior to departure is a 20% cancellation fee
- 60 days prior to departure is a 30% cancellation fee
- 30 days prior to departure is a 50% cancellation fee
- 20 days or less prior to departure is 100% cancellation fee
